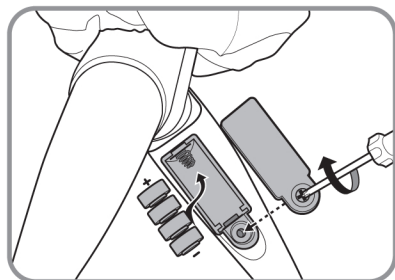


BATTERY REPLACEMENT

ADULTS NOTE: Batteries included are for demonstration purposes only. Remove these batteries and dispose of them safely. To replace batteries, use a Phillips head screwdriver (not included) to open battery cover. Insert 4 new AG13 button cell batteries as shown. Use either AG 13 (LR44) button cell batteries or equivalent. Replace battery cover and tighten screw. Replace the batteries when sound becomes distorted. Do not connect to more than the recommended number of power supplies. Dispose of batteries safely. When exposed to an electrostatic source, the product may malfunction. If this problem occurs, reset the product by reinstalling the batteries.



BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

In exceptional circumstances batteries may leak fluids that can cause a chemical burn injury or ruin your product. To avoid battery leakage:

- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the product before being charged.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.

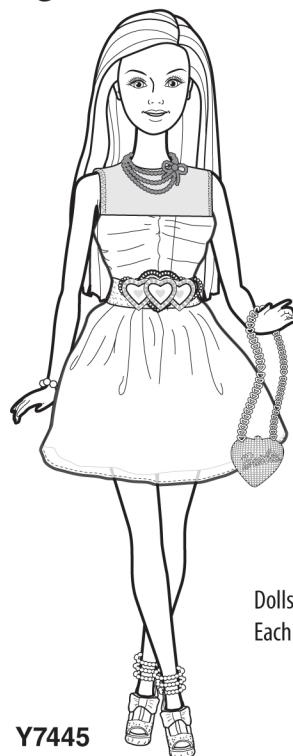

Record

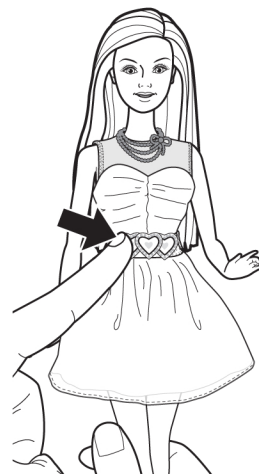


Press and hold the middle button to record. Release to make doll repeat what you just said. Last recording will erase when new recording occurs.

Note: Maximum 6 seconds of audio can be stored. For best performance, speak into the microphone 2 inches away in a quiet environment.



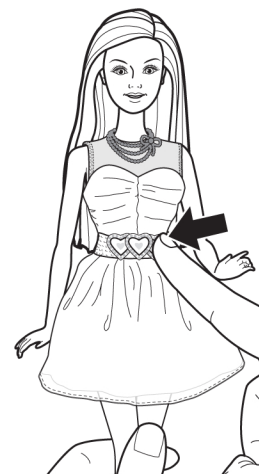
Playback
